

**BYLAW 23-015
OF
LAC LA BICHE COUNTY**

A BYLAW OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING PUBLIC TRAVEL AND DISPOSING OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROADWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, R.S.A 2000, CHAPTER M-26, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel;

AND WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have portions of the public roadway closed;

AND WHEREAS the Council of Lac La Biche County deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof situated, in the said Municipality, and thereafter disposing of same;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by a person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of Lac La Biche County in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of disposing of the following, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

1. PLAN 922 0790
CONNECTING ROAD AND EXTRA AREA
WITHIN SE ¼ SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 66, RANGE 15, WEST OF FOURTH MERIDIAN
CONTAINING 0.834 HECTARES (2.06 ACRES) MORE OR LESS
EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

As identified in Schedule "A", attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

Severability

2. Each provision of this Bylaw is independent of all other provisions. If any such provision is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions of this Bylaw will remain valid and enforceable.

Effective Date

3. This bylaw shall come into effect upon passing of the third reading.
