

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION – OWL RIVER FILL STATION

Dear Residents:

Lac La Biche County is committed to enhancing our infrastructure and is pleased to announce the continuation of the Owl River Fill Station project. This essential project provides residents with access to potable water near the Owl River Recreation Centre and provides the Owl River Fire Hall with access to a larger water reservoir. A map of the general location and work area is attached.

The fill house and underground water reservoir were completed as part of the work started in 2025, and the fill station is currently accessible to residents. The remaining work will complete the loop road and final site improvements to improve access, traffic flow, and site restoration.

Construction Timeline: May 25, 2026, to June 22, 2026 (*weather permitting*)

Hours of Work: 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (Mondays to Saturday)

Scope of Work: The remaining work includes earthworks; excavation and recompaction of areas temporarily backfilled prior to winter; ditch and approach improvements; subgrade and base preparation; asphalt concrete pavement on the loop road; pavement markings; and seeding.

Large trucks will be hauling material to and from the construction site along Highway 858 and Range Road 135. Construction signage and safety messaging will be installed as required.

K-Rite Construction will work diligently to maintain public safety and complete the work within the project schedule.

TEMPORARY FILL STATION CLOSURE

For public safety, the fill station will be closed to residential users during road construction due to active work areas and construction equipment on site. The closure is expected to be in effect from **Wednesday, May 27th to Monday, June 15th, 2026**, weather permitting.

Alternative Truck Fill Locations: During the temporary closure, residents may access the following alternative truck fill locations:

- **Summit Heights Reservoir** – 13439 Lakeland Drive
- **Airport Reservoir** – 67014 Mission Road
- **Plamondon Reservoir** – 67578 Rge Rd 161

Lac La Biche County apologizes for any inconvenience this temporary closure may cause and appreciates residents' patience and cooperation while this work is completed.



Impact to Residents and Local Traffic:

- Construction activities may cause minimal disruption to public traffic on Range Road 135. Lane closures may be required; however, one open lane will be maintained at all times.
- Heavy equipment and truck traffic will be moving in and out of the work site.
- Residents and passing traffic are advised to use caution near the work area and follow all posted signage and directions from crew personnel.
- A dedicated site person may be assigned to guide the public and traffic, as required.
- Garbage pick-up will continue normally.
- Safety, signage, and dust control will be monitored throughout construction.

Special Instructions for Residents and local traffic:

Please be mindful of all installed construction signage and safety messages. Maintain a safe distance from construction work and do not enter marked, flagged or barricaded areas. Always follow traffic directions from all crew personnel during construction operations. We anticipate the remaining loop road, site, and road improvement work to be completed by June 22, 2026, weather permitting.
