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PROCEDURE:

- Bursary will be advertised in the local paper and county newsletter for 2 weeks in September as well as
 provided to all local high schools, Portage College and applicable learning institutions. The ASB may
 modify the advertising or application period.
- 2. Applications will be reviewed at the October Agricultural Service Board meeting. If there is no October meeting, applications will be reviewed at the next ASB sitting or done virtually.
- 3. Applicant must be attending an accredited post-secondary institution in an agricultural or related field. Applicants enrolled in a pre-requisite entry program may not qualify.
- 4. Applicant or parent(s)/guardian(s) of applicant must be a Lac La Biche County resident.
- 5. Applicant must provide proof of enrollment prior to the bursary being awarded. The ASB reserves the right to verify supporting documentation submitted as part of the application.
- 6. Applicant must provide proof of successful completion of studies. Lac La Biche County Agricultural Service Board reserves the right to request repayment of bursary should the applicant drop/fail or switch their initial program to an unrelated field.
- 7. Applications will be reviewed on a competitive basis by the Agricultural Service Board.
- 8. Applicants may apply for more than one scholastic year, up to a maximum of four (4) scholastic years for degrees and two (2) academic years for a diploma.
- 9. Applicants may only receive one (1) bursary per scholastic year.

- 10. The Agricultural Service Board offers two (2) bursaries of \$1,000.00 each per year, each year. Distribution of funds will consist of two (2) equal payments of \$500.00.
- 11. Applications are to be made on a specified form (Schedule A) to be submitted with a cover letter and supporting documents.
- 12. If not enough requests are processed to expend the funds by year-end, the funds will not be carried over. Only two (2) bursaries will be awarded per calendar year.
