



FALL ROADSIDE CLEANUP 2026

Applications will be accepted until September 14, 2026. Lac La Biche County will approve roadside clean up location(s) prior to collection start date.

Items provided by Lac La Biche County:

- Roadside clean up locations
- Garbage bags
- Gloves
- Safety vests

Rates paid for cleanup are:

- Urban (roadways within 5 km of the Hamlets of Lac La Biche and Plamondon) are \$150/km of roadway right of way cleaned on both sides.
- Rural is \$100/km of roadway right of way cleaned on both sides.
- All work shall be inspected by Lac La Biche County prior to payment.

Requirements

All members of community group **MUST** wear a vest while in Lac La Biche County Road Right of Ways performing clean-up or collection of garbage bags/debris.

All groups will at their expense and without limiting its liabilities herein, insure its operations under a contract of comprehensive, or Commercial General liability with an insurer licensed in Alberta, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, (annual general aggregate, if any not less than \$2,000,000) insuring against injury, personal injury, and property damage including loss and use thereof.

Bag Collections

If the group is conducting clean-up in one area on a single date, please inform the County contact. Clean-up dates must be pre-scheduled to confirm garbage bag pickup. All garbage shall be picked up by Lac La Biche County on the Monday following the weekend cleanup.

If clean-up for one area is scheduled over multiple days, bags and debris disposal is the responsibility of the community group. Bags and debris may **not** be left out for over 48 hours.
