

UPCOMING COMMUNITY PEACE OFFICER INDUCTION PROGRAM (CPOIP)

Lac La Biche County continues to strongly work in partnership with Alberta Justice and Solicitor General to deliver a wide range of training to Community Peace Officers and other law enforcement professionals in Alberta. We are excited to announce our upcoming 2023 CPOIP classes!

Spring - March 20, 2023 - June 1, 2023

Fall - August 21, 2023 - November 2, 2023

This intensive 11-week program covers a wide variety of training including: legal studies, physical fitness, strategic communication, use of force training, shotgun training, RADAR/LiDAR training, and the Emergency Vehicle Operators Course (EVOC). This program is accredited by the Alberta Justice and Solicitor General.



This program is open to both self-funded students, and students who are employed by a municipality. Training is conducted 10-hours per day, 4-days per week. The cost of the program includes accommodations, thanks to our partner Portage College.
