Petition of Objection August 24, 2013

This petition is in response to the August 12, 2013 letter advising of a Rezoning Application (Bylaw No. 12-053 and No. 13-021). We, the undersigned object in principle to the Bylaw objectives for the reasons and perspectives contained herein.

The application raises some serious concerns for the property owners of the existing Elinor Lake development. To date the first Phase remains only about 50% sold out with no predictability on the sale of the remaining lots. Furthermore, and as concerning, is the fact that obligations under the current contract such as road development and completion have not been satisfactorily fulfilled. Despite ongoing discussion for roadway improvement and correction, deficiencies still exist and quality of work done remains under dispute.

Proceeding with further development of new properties or lots at this time appears premature in the extreme. We are gravely concerned further expansion at this time will have a deleterious impact on the property valuations for all existing and prospective owners. The Developer should hold a Public Forum and consult with all those who hold a vested interest in the proposal. This may provide some insight into the existing issues and some optimization for long term planning for all concerned.

For the foregoing concerns we, the undersigned, are vehemently opposed to the proposed rezoning and sincerely hope the request is not considered favorably.
