

Procedure for application and installation of Natural Gas Services

- 1. The customer must contact Utility Services to obtain an estimate for the installation of a new Natural Gas service line.
- 2. The customer will need to supply a copy of the development permit, the BTU load and sizing of service for the location, along with the service address, the legal land location and contact number or email address.
- 3. Utility staff will visit the site to take measurements and decide where service will run.
- 4. Utility Services will then create the estimate and send the information to the customer by email.
- 5. Once the customer receives the estimate, they will need to go to the main County building to fill out a Natural Gas application and contract, and to pay the deposit for the future Natural Gas service installation.
- 6. Once the application and contract are filled out and the deposit has been paid, the Natural Gas utility staff will then install the service line on the property.
- 7. The gas fitter doing the piping for the home must do an air test and fill out a Service Completion Notification with the total BTU rating for each appliance.
- 8. The Gas fitter must complete and email a copy of the Gas Permit and Service Completion Notification to Utility Services for the work done in the home.
- 9. The system must be inspected by a Safety Code Officer before service will be turned on.
- 10. Once service is activated and all requirements have been fulfilled, Utility Services will complete final billing and send to the customer.

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
