



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Lac La Biche Hamlet Churchill Drive Water and Sewer Replacement & Other Work

Dear Property Owners/Residents:

Lac La Biche County, Canadian Consulting Engineers and Kelsey Pipelines Ltd. have started work in the area. Road surface work for the 2nd lift of asphalt concrete pavement (ACP), along 101A Street and a section of 104 Avenue, is scheduled to start June 2nd. Contact information has been updated for Kelsey Pipelines Ltd., and an updated diagram of the work area is attached.

Timeline: May 20, 2025 to August 30, 2025 (weather permitting)
Scope of Work: Watermains, sanitary sewers, storm sewers, roads, curbs and gutters and road surface work.
Hours of Work: 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. (Monday to Saturday)
9 a.m. – 5 p.m. (Sunday and Holidays)

Impact to Residents and Local Traffic:

- Local traffic will be impacted, signage and barricades will be in place for the project duration.
- Temporary road interruption and/or closure.
- Alternating one-lane traffic flow during road surface work on 2nd lift sections.
- Regular haul truck movement throughout the hamlet.
- Waste & Recycling collection locations may be affected.
- Temporary water service connections have been arranged with the tenant/homeowner.

Please respect all construction signage and barricades, and we ask that the public stay clear of the work area and haul routes.
