

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Lac La Biche Hamlet 100 Street Water Main Replacement

Dear Property Owners/Residents:

Lac La Biche County, and Van-Ross Contracting have made great progress with the water main replacement and now require temporary closure of the South entrance to McArthur Place from **Tuesday, Sept. 30**th to **Thursday, October 2**nd. A temporary detour map is attached for reference.

Overall Timeline: September 19, 2025, to October 30, 2025
Scope of Work: Excavation, Water Main Replacement
Hours of Work: 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. (Monday to Saturday)

9 a.m. - 5 p.m. (Sunday and Holidays)

Impact to Residents and Local Traffic:

- Temporary access to McArthur Place off 100 Street, will be from the North entrance (lakeside).
- Regular haul truck movement throughout the hamlet.
- Waste & Recycling collection location may be affected.
- Temporary water measures have been arranged with affected households/businesses.

Please respect all construction signage and barricades and ask that the public stay clear of the work area and haul routes.


