

## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Lac La Biche Hamlet  
104 Street Water Main Replacement

**Dear Property Owners/Residents:**

Lac La Biche County, MPE and Van-Ross Contracting will soon begin work in your residential area. The existing cast iron water main will be replaced to current standards with minimal disturbance to the road, curb and gutter along 104 Street. A diagram of the work area is attached.

**Timeline:** July 14, 2025, to August 09, 2025 (weather permitting)  
**Scope of Work:** Excavation, Water Main Replacement  
**Hours of Work:** 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. (Monday to Saturday)  
9 a.m. – 5 p.m. (Sunday and Holidays)

**Impact to Residents and Local Traffic:**

- Local traffic will be impacted, and signage and barricades will be in place for the duration.
- Regular haul truck movement throughout the hamlet.
- Waste & Recycling collection location may be affected.
- Temporary water service may be required and arranged with affected locations.

Please respect all construction signage and barricades. We ask that the public stay clear of the work area and haul routes.

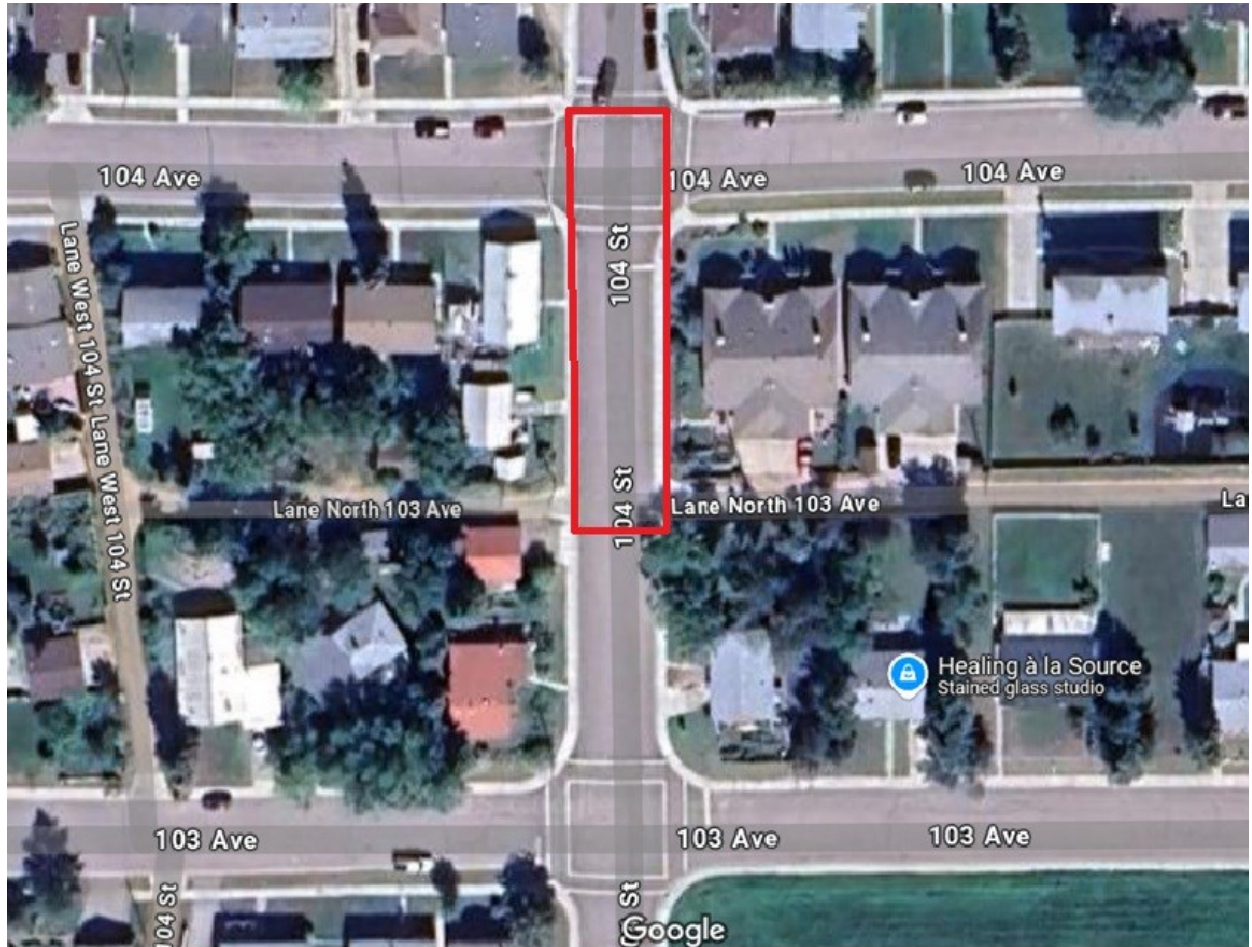
