

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION (Update)

Tarrabain Drive
GBC, ACP and Other Work

Dear Property Owners/Residents:

Lac La Biche County would like to announce that the Tarrabain Drive Base and Pave project is scheduled to be complete before the July long weekend this year. E-Construction will start mobilizing their equipment to site after the May long weekend, and start construction May 29.

A diagram of the work area is attached. The contractors will do their best to accommodate traffic through the work zone. However, residents can expect delays while the work is being completed and may wish to utilize an alternate route.

Timeline:	May 29 to June 30, 2023 (weather-dependent)
Scope of Work:	Grading, Granular Base Course (GBC), Paving (ACP) and Other Work
Hours of Work:	7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Saturday, including holidays.

Impact to Residents and Local Traffic:

- Local Traffic Only signage will be posted.
- 30 km/hr speed limit along Tarrabain Drive while work is in progress.
- Culvert Replacement in Approaches.
- Intermittent single lane closures. Flaggers will be present when required.
- Construction signs and safety messages will be installed along the construction zone.
- Heavy equipment and truck traffic moving in/out of work site.

All County representatives will take every precaution to ensure public safety. We request your assistance in keeping children and pets a safe distance from the construction site, staff and equipment.
