#### 1. GENERAL GUIDELINES:

Council has established procedures to be taken in the removal of beaver and beaver dams affecting County infrastructure and private land.

#### 3. PROCEDURE:

#### General

- 1. Removal of beavers will commence in the spring by an in-house County staff person supplemented with a contracted trapper. The in-house staff person will be available from April until the end of May annually. At this point, a contracted trapper would continue with the trapping for the balance of the season (April to September). Traps set would be left in place over the balance of the season and be regularly checked and reset as necessary.
- 2. The trapper is to remove problem beavers on beaver dams affecting County right-of-ways (ROW), infrastructure and from private land on a fee-for-service basis.
- 3. Removal of dams and/or beavers shall be done by authorized personnel in accordance with federal and provincial legislation, including the Agricultural Pest Act, Fisheries Act, Species at Risk Act (SARA) and Alberta's Water Act.
- 4. Dam removal using explosives will be limited to September 1 September 30 in order to meet activity restrictions imposed by the Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO) and Alberta Environmental Protection to protect spawning and fish habitat, birds and amphibians.
- 5. Prior to any contracted beaver dam blasting, the blaster will ensure that all legal and safety requirements have been fulfilled and proper authorities have been notified. A call to Alberta First Call will be completed prior to work commencing, at the discretion of the Blaster. Environmental Services will notify adjacent landowners if necessary.

- 6. Environmental Services will submit a Beaver Harvest Report to Fish and Wildlife at the end of the season. A copy of the report will be kept in the County's Environmental Services office.
- 7. The trapper will be allowed to retain the beaver carcasses as part of the remuneration for services.

#### Requests for Service – Public and County Land

- 1. Alberta Transportation is responsible for the maintenance of road culverts blocked by beaver on all primary and secondary highways, therefore landowners requesting service on these locations shall be directed to their department for remedial action.
- Environmental Services staff will coordinate with other County departments for the removal of beaver dams and cleaning of culverts for the protection of county infrastructure and public safety. Transportation will determine whether protective devices are warranted on culverts with chronic beaver problems.
- 3. Beaver and beaver dam removal to alleviate flooding or any other environmental issues on County property (including Municipal Reserve) will be coordinated between the Environmental Services and Transportation departments. This includes the impact of water flow at inflow/outflow locations around any lake or water body. In these events, the County will be responsible for all associated control costs.
- 4. The County will notify appropriate downstream landholders of the intent and approximate date of water release from dam removals. Responses from all those notified must be received by Transportation or Environmental Services prior to the commencement of any work with any conditions or objections noted.
- 5. Beaver control requests for non-flooding damage (i.e. trees) can be referred to County trapper for resolution.
- 6. Environmental Services will issue work orders to Trapper, authorizing the beaver control work.

#### Requests for Service - Private Land

- 1. Dam removal may be undertaken on private land at County expense, through a Public Works request, if the dam in question is flooding the adjacent ROW or poses a potential threat to County property. The County will obtain all necessary permits prior to conducting dam removal work.
- 2. Applicants requesting private beaver dam removal are required to sign a Permission to Enter Upon Lands (Schedule A) waiver and a Hold Harmless Agreement (Schedule B) prior to any control work being done by the County or an agent of the County.
- 3. Applicants may be charged fee for service for beaver dam blasting done by the County or an agent of the County for private land. Prices will vary depending on the scope of the work performed. Blasting work is subject to blaster availability.
- 4. Applicants will be charged heavy equipment rates as outlined in the Alberta Road Builders & Heavy Construction Rate Guide for any equipment used to remove beaver dams by the County or an agent of the County. Heavy equipment work is subject to the availability of equipment, labor and necessary approvals by government agencies.
