Low Pressure Sewer System
Owner to sign water & sewer service completion notification and this inspection indicating that Lac La Biche County will not be held liable in case of damage incurred on private property in the event of a sewage backup.
Pump installed in two compartment tank or separate pump chamber to pump effluent only.
Effluent Pump installed according to specifications.
Backflow preventer check valve at pump discharge.
No drainage or any other water than sanitary wastewater allowed to enter tank.
Gravity Sewer System
Sewer piping and fitting are ABS or PVC from building drain to property line.
Maintain minimum grade as per pipe size.
All elbows are 22 ½ or 45's, no 90's
Owner to sign water & sewer service completion notification and this inspection indicating that Lac La Biche County will not be held liable in case of damage incurred on private property in the event of a sewage backup.
Recommended to owner to install an approved backflow preventer on the building sewer drain for either pressure system or gravity.
It is the homeowner's responsibility to maintain all water and sewer equipment and piping from their installation to the property connections. This includes ground settlement, line blockage and frost protection. Lac La Biche County will not be held liable for any damages incurred on private property. Lac La Biche County will not be responsible for the failure of fittings that have been supplied.
