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BYLAW 13-038 OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY

A BYLAW OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BYLAW 12-024, BEING THE LAND USE BYLAW OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY.

WHEREAS Council has adopted Bylaw 12-024 to be used as the Lac La Biche County Land Use Bylaw; and

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend Bylaw 12-024 as set out in Section 692 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M 26, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, and by virtue of all other powers enabling it, the Council of Lac La Biche County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That "Work Camps" be deleted from Section 11 Definitions and that the following definitions be added to Section 11 Definitions:

Work Camp Minor Temporary means any camp which meets any of the following:

- Minimum fourteen days operation to a maximum of one year with the option to renew for another year.
- Minimum housing of ten workers to a maximum of twenty workers.
- Minimum of one prefabricated multi accommodation unit.
- Minimum of one prefabricated eating / washroom / shower unit.

Work Camp Minor Permanent means any camp which meets any of the following:

- Minimum of two years operation.
- Minimum housing of ten workers to a maximum of twenty workers.
- Minimum of one prefabricated multi accommodation unit.
- Minimum of one prefabricated eating / washroom / shower unit.

Work Camps Major Temporary means any camp which meets all of the following:

- Minimum fourteen days operation to a maximum of one year with the option to renew for another year.
- Minimum housing of twenty one workers.
- Minimum of one prefabricated multi accommodation unit.
- Minimum of one prefabricated eating / washroom / shower unit.

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Work Camps Major Permanent means any camp which meets all of the following:

- Minimum two years operations.
- Minimum housing of twenty one workers.
- Minimum of one prefabricated multi accommodation unit.
- Minimum of one prefabricated eating / washroom / shower unit.

Work Camps Open means any camp that is open to the public and meets all of the following:

- Minimum two years operations.
- Minimum housing of twenty one workers.
- Minimum of one prefabricated multi accommodation unit.
- Minimum of one prefabricated eating / washroom / shower unit.
- 2. That Section 105 (1) be deleted and the following be added:
 - 1(a) All work camps require a Development permit.
 - (b) All work camps except "Work Camps Open" must be an Accessory Use to an industrial or resource development use.
- 3. That "Work Camp Minor Temporary, Work Camp Minor Permanent, Work Camp Major Temporary Work Camp Major Permanent and Work Camp Open" be added to Section 108 Agriculture District (AG) subsection (2) Discretionary Uses.
- 4. That "Work Camp" be deleted from Section 109 Crown Land District (CL) subsection 2 (b) Discretionary Uses.
- 5. That "Work Camp Minor Temporary, Work Camp Minor Permanent, Work Camp Major Temporary Work Camp Major Permanent and Work Camp Open" be added to Section 109 Crown Land District subsection 2(a) Permitted Uses.
- 6. That "Work Camp" be deleted from Section 125 Rural Industrial District (RI) subsection 2 (b) Discretionary Uses and that "Work Camp Minor Temporary, Work Camp Minor Permanent, Work Camp Major Temporary and Work Camp Major Permanent" be added to Section 125 subsection 2(b).
- 7. This bylaw shall come into effect upon passing of the third reading.
