Life is a highway...but who maintains the highway?

Taking care of local roads is a collaborative effort between Lac La Biche County and the Province of Alberta. In addition to cost-share agreements for sweeping and snow-removal on Main Street, Lac La Biche and Main Street, Plamondon, the two levels of government are each responsible for different roads.

Lac La Biche County repairs and maintains an extensive system of rural roads, bridges, urban streets and sidewalks. The transportation department also provides dust suppression in front of the Beaver Lake Landfill and to residents on Highway 663.

The Province of Alberta is responsible for maintenance of all highways throughout Lac La Biche County. This includes Main Street in Lac La Biche and Plamondon, Highways 55, 663, and 858, and the intersection of Provincial Highways 36 at 881. Service on these roads is carried out by contractors and includes: pothole repair, grading, snow plowing, dust control, sanding, road kill pickup, plugged culverts, damaged road signs, mowing, and weed control.

Rural Roads, Urban Streets, and Sidewalk Maintenance

To report an issue with a rural road, an urban street, or a sidewalk, residents have a few options:

1) SeeClickFix - Download the free SeeClickFix app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store, submit your request, and you'll get live updates as the issue is resolved.

2) Email - You can also email your request to transportationservices@laclabichecounty.com. If you choose this route, please include the location, any nearby landmarks, and a detailed description of the damage.

3) Phone - For residents who do not have Internet access or prefer to call, you can phone 780-623-6736 or 780-623-6811 to report needed maintenance.

In an emergency, such as a collapsed bridge or flooded intersection, please call the after hours line at 780-404-4078.

Lac La Biche County Property Tax Payment Options

Lac La Biche County property taxes were due July 31, 2020 but did you know we offer monthly payment options for rate payers to pay their property taxes? By signing up for 1 of 2 payment options you are not subject to any future penalties, if the agreement is being followed.

Option 1: Monthly Autopay (TIPP) Program

This program is for 2020 tax levies and penalties. The autopay program is a simple and secure way to pay your annual property taxes. When you sign up for the program, monthly payments are automatically withdrawn from your bank account on the 1st of each month as part of a pre-authorized debit agreement.

Option 2: Tax Payment Plan Program

This program is for arrears, current tax levies and penalties. The Tax Payment Plan Program is designed to calculate the tax arrears, current taxes, previous penalties and other transferred balances into an economical monthly payment. The payment plan can be over a few months or up to a maximum of 36 months. An agreement must be signed, and monthly payments are automatically withdrawn from your bank account on either the 1st or 15th of the month.
