

# Council *Highlights*

## **Sale of Stored Assets (Four Basketball Nets)**

Administration asked Council for feedback on what to do with four basketball nets that can't be used in Bold Center facilities. After deliberation, Council requested that Administration offer the basketball nets to community groups for use rather than sell them.

## **Council Appointment to Public Works Committee**

Councillor Thompson resigned from the Public Works Committee. After receiving a nomination, Councillor David Phillips was appointed to the Public Works Committee.

## **CAO Six-Month Probation Review**

After an in-camera discussion, Council voted unanimously to conclude the probationary period of the Chief Administrative Officer's employment contract. Going forward, Shadia Amblie will be Lac La Biche County's full-time, permanent CAO.

## **Budget Adoption: Deferral**

Council chose to defer the adoption of the 2016 budget to March 22, 2016's Regular Council Meeting. Council will carry out final discussions on the capital budget on that date.

## **Lakeland Interpretive Society: Request for a Task Force**

The Lakeland Interpretive Society is charged with maintaining and expanding the Lac La Biche Museum, currently located in McArthur Place's basement. After noting that water leaks in the building put the museum's artifacts at risk, Lakeland Interpretive Society officials asked for Council's help in finding a permanent home.

Council denied the creation of a task force dedicated to finding the museum a new location. However, a majority of Councillors voted in favour of discussing a permanent location for the museum at a future Council Meeting.
