Range Road 144 – Minor Grading, Granular Base Course, Asphalt Concrete Pavement (EPS) and other work for approximately 6.194 kilometers. The estimated quantities included in the Unit Price Schedule are 45,000 cubic meters of common excavation, 3,300 cubic meters of borrow excavation (Contractor's supply), 70,300 square meters of Subgrade Surface Preparation, 38,250 tonnes of Granular Base Course and 13,150 tonnes of Asphalt Concrete Pavement - Mix Type M1 (PG 46-34). **All aggregates are to be supplied by the Contractor from sources of its choice with No Option.**

A non-refundable cheque deposit of One-Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) made payable to Opus Stewart Weir Ltd. will be required for each set of tender documents provided. Tenders must be accompanied by a Bid Bond and a Consent of Surety as stated in the "Instructions to Bidders".

Contracts will only be awarded to Bidders who, prior to the time fixed for receiving tenders, possess a Certificate of Recognition (COR) which is relevant to their industry and which is recognized by Alberta Labour, Occupational Health and Safety. Bidders are advised that a small employer's certificate of recognition (for employers with less than ten employees) is not considered acceptable.

Lac La Biche County reserves the right to reject any or all Tenders, and to waive irregularities, information, and non-compliance at its sole discretion. The County reserves the right to accept a Tender other than the lowest Tender without stating reasons, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing: The County may consider any other factor(s), besides price, capability to perform the work and proposed specifications, in its sole and unfettered discretion. By submitting its Tender, the Bidder waives any right to claim, in any proceeding or court action, for loss of anticipated profit or any other damages in excess of the reasonable costs incurred by the Bidder preparing its Tender.

The Contractors are advised that the specifications for Work to be performed under this Contract shall be in accordance with the Government of Alberta Transportation manuals "Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, Edition 15, 2013", "Specifications for Bridge Construction – 2013", and the Special Provisions of this Contract. These specifications are supplemented by those published in the Government of Alberta Transportation manual entitled "General Specifications, Specification Amendments and Supplemental Specifications for Highway and Bridge Construction, Edition 15, 2013" and the General Conditions contained in Part VI.

The Contract Completion date for the Work is August 31, 2017.
