Alberta Transportation

- Representatives of Alberta Transportation, the provincial ministry in charge of highways, attended Council's meeting to discuss Highways 858 and 663. Council wishes to see improvements to these highways to promote traffic safety.
- After a discussion, Council voted to schedule a meeting in September with Alberta Transportation officials.

New Business

New Recreation Facility Rates, Fees and Charges Bylaw

- Council gave second and third readings to a new bylaw, setting rates, fees and charges for County recreation facilities for the next three years. The new bylaw came into effect on September 1.

- Existing admission, membership and facility rentals fees remain the same this year as the previous year. The following two years will each see a two per cent increase across the board, effective September 1 of each year. These increases will be rounded to the nearest \$0.25.
