LAC LA BICHE STORM OUTLET IMPROVEMENTS 101 STREET & 104 STREET AND MCARTHUR PARK OIL GRIT SEPARATOR LAC LA BICHE, ALBERTA

INVITATION TO TENDER

SEALED TENDERS, marked "Lac La Biche Storm Outlet Improvements (101 Street & 104 Street) and McArthur Park Oil Grit Separator" must be received by 2:00 p.m., local time, Tuesday June 12th, 2018, at the 2nd Floor of McArthur Place, 10307 100th Street, Lac La Biche, Alberta.

The work includes the rehabilitation of three storm outlets between 101 Street and 104 Street which discharge into Lac La Biche Lake, including the installation of Oil/Grit Separators. Also included is the installation of one Oil/Grit Separator within McArthur Park. Due to environmental restrictions, the construction of the three storm outlet rehabilitations must occur between July 16 and November 1, with a small portion of the work within the lake restricted to between July 16 and September 14. The McArthur Park Oil Grit Separator installation is not restricted by environmental regulations. Green Plan Ltd. has prepared two Limited Environmental Overviews (included as Additional Disbursements) which outline requirements and restrictions which must be adhered to by the successful contractor during the execution of this contract.

The work includes the following major items:

- Replacement of 2 - 300mm storm outlets with gabion basket channels and flared ends.
- Replacement of 1 - 525mm storm outlet with a 600mm storm outlet and flared end.
- 2 inline Oil/Grit Separators including manhole structures.
- 2 inline Oil/Grit Separators including manhole structures and grated catch basin inlets.
- Localized asphalt trail, concrete curb, and asphalt roadway restoration at each outlet.
- Environmental oversight carried out by Qualified Aquatic Environmental Specialist (QAES)

Tenders must be accompanied by a Certified Cheque or Bid Bond in the amount of Ten Percent (10%) of the Tender Price, made payable to the Lac La Biche County. Plans and specifications may be reviewed at the office of V3 Companies of Canada Ltd.

A Performance Guarantee and Maintenance Bond in an amount equal to Fifty Percent (50%) of the Contract Sum and a Labour & Materials Payment Bond in an amount equal to Fifty Percent (50%) of the Contract Sum shall be required from the successful bidder.

The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. It is the responsibility of the Tenderer to check for any Addenda for this project on Alberta Purchasing Connection (APC) prior to the close of the tender period.
