- Capable of ordering and receiving parts for repair purposes.

- Perform Commercial Vehicle Inspections (CVIP)
- Maintain clean and orderly service truck, shop facilities and help to maintain small tools and supplies
- Ensure that all chemicals located on County Centre site are kept in accordance with provincial regulations and are clearly labelled and properly stored
- Operate vehicles, tractors, skid steer trucks, graders and various types of equipment as required
- Follow all Lac La Biche County safety protocols and procedures
- Perform all assigned tasks with efficiency and good workmanship
- Able to respond and assist in Wild land firefighting
- All other duties as assigned by the Manager of Equipment Services
