Lac La Biche County recognizes the need to supply used culverts and grader blades to County residents. Sale of used culverts and grader blades to County residents is a practical and environmentally responsible way of disposing of these items as it promotes re-use of materials.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Lac La Biche County will sell used grader blades from County graders and used culverts that have been salvaged from grading projects within the County. These materials will be made available to the public at the County Centre.
- 2. Culverts will be sold for one-half (½) the price of the current County cost of new culverts. Couplers are not included.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the resident to pick up the used culverts or grader blades.
- 4. Culverts shall only be used for the resident's private use on private lands and shall not be used for the construction of new approaches on County right of ways or on any portion of unimproved road allowances under the jurisdiction of Lac La Biche County.
- 5. A limit of 15 used grader blades will be sold to a resident per year at a cost of \$4.00 per used blade.
- 6. A price schedule will be implemented for all sizes of used culverts, based on current prices of new culverts.
