

**BYLAW 24-011

A BYLAW OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A SUBDIVISION EXTENSION BYLAW.

---

**WHEREAS** Council may by bylaw, pursuant to Section 203 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, delegate any of its powers, duties or functions to a council committee or any person.

**NOW THEREFORE** under the authority and subject to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, and by virtue of all other powers enabling it, the Council of Lac La Biche County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

**Bylaw 24-011**

**Title**

1 This bylaw is called the "Subdivision Extension Bylaw".

**Application**

2 The authority to grant extensions to the periods of time referred to in Section 657(1) and 657(5) of the Municipal Government Act as provided for in Section 657(6) of the Municipal Government Act is delegated to the Chief Administrative Officer.

3 The Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to further delegate to any employee of the municipality.

**Severability**

4 Each provision of this Bylaw is independent of all other provisions. If any such provision is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions of this Bylaw will remain valid and enforceable.

**Rescinding of Previous Policy**

5 The Conditional Subdivision Approval Time Extension Policy of Lac La Biche County is hereby rescinded.

**Effective Date**

6 This Bylaw shall come into effect upon passing of the third reading.
