## BYLAW 07-005 OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY

A BYLAW OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH THE DESIGNATED OFFICER POSITION OF MUNICIPAL ASSESSOR.

WHEREAS under the authority and pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M 26, R.S.A. 2000, and amendments thereto, Council may, by Bylaw, establish the position of designated officers;

AND WHEREAS the Council of Lac La Biche County wishes to establish the officer of a Municipal Assessor, this position shall be subordinate to the Chief Administrative Officer;

NOW THEREFORE under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of the said Municipal Act, and by virtue of all other enabling powers, the Council of Lac La Biche County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Lakeland County's Bylaw 07-017 and the Town of Lac La Biche's Bylaw NO. 1185/01 are hereby repealed.
- 2. The office of the Municipal Assessor for the Lac La Biche County is hereby established.
- 3. The office of the Municipal Assessor shall be a designated officer as set out in the Municipal Government Act and shall be subordinate to the Chief Administrative Officer.
- 4. Duties, powers and functions of the appointed assessor shall be in accordance with Part 9 Division 1 of the MGA not including Section 292.
- 5. The appointment to this position shall be made by resolution of council.
- 6. This Bylaw shall come into effect upon passing of third reading.
