RELEASE FOR HERBICIDE APPLICATION

I hereby grant permission for the Lac La Biche County Environmental Services staff to apply residual herbicide within the property listed below, for the control of noxious weeds and/or brush along the perimeter of the property, including the fence line and headlands, and into adjacent road right-of-way. I understand that herbicide applications will be subject to availability of spray resources and weather conditions. This signed request will include permission for the Lac La Biche County to enter my property for the purpose of performing such related weed control work.

I understand the effects of the listed herbicides and agree to their application on my property: *(Check herbicides allowed)*

Lontrel 360® is a slightly residual herbicide with low toxicity, which may persist in the soil for up to two years and may affect the growth of crops such as peas, beans, potatoes, all legumes, and other broadleaf crops. I hereby declare that I understand the residual effects of Lontrel 360®. I agree to save harmless and indemnify the Lac La Biche County, its employees and agents, from and against all actions, suits, claims and demands arising in any manner whatsoever from activities associated with said herbicide application.

Milestone® is a residual herbicide with low toxicity, which may persist in the soil for up to three years and may affect the growth of crops such as canola, peas, beans, potatoes, all legumes, and other broadleaf crops. I hereby declare that I understand the residual effects of Milestone®. I agree to save harmless and indemnify the Lac La Biche County, its employees and agents, from and against all actions, suits, claims and demands arising in any manner whatsoever from activities associated with said herbicide application.

Tordon 22K® is a residual herbicide with low toxicity, which may persist in the soil for up to five years and may affect the growth of crops such as canola, peas, beans, potatoes, all legumes, brush, and other broadleaf crops. I hereby declare that I understand the residual effects of Tordon 22K®. I agree to save harmless and indemnify the Lac La Biche County, its employees and agents, from and against all actions, suits, claims and demands arising in any manner whatsoever from activities associated with said herbicide application.

Permit the application of herbicides for the control of prohibited noxious and noxious weeds upon the terms and subject to the CONDITIONS herein stated.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the "Municipality" and the "Owner" agree as follows:

1. The "Municipality" shall be permitted to enter on to the mentioned lands to apply herbicides to control weeds.
2. The "Municipality" is providing the herbicide application work at no charge.
3. The "Municipality" shall not be deemed to represent, warrant or guarantee that the application of the herbicide control products will be effective or safe for the purpose for which it is to be used. The "Owner" assumes the entire responsibility for any adverse effects.
4. In consideration of the weed control measures performed, the "Owner" for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, agrees that neither the "Municipality" performing the said work shall be under any responsibility for destruction of or damages to other property of the "Owner" which may result from the application of weed control activities, whether due to negligence of the "Municipality" or any employee of the "Municipality" performing the said work or otherwise.
5. The "Owner" represents that he is the "Owner" of the lands and agrees to indemnify and save harmless Lac La Biche County, its agents and/or its employees in respect to any claims or demands which may at any time hereafter be brought against Lac La Biche County performing the said work by any person, firm or corporation by reason of the performance of the said work.
6. Any previous agreements with Lac La Biche County signed or implied on or about the above date for the said legal land description are invalid/void and any conditions carried or implied within these agreements.
7. This agreement is consistent with the Integrated Vegetation Management Policy and Procedure PI-63-002.
