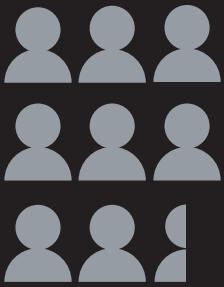




Lac La Biche County
